## **Maker Faire Trieste**

Date: 31 August - 1 September 2024

**Venue**: piazza dell'Unità d'Italia, Trieste

Language: Italian (with some English)

Format: 2 day event: MFTS current format is in downtown Trieste and reaches both the general public and people who already have an interest in science&technology, including school educators/teachers. Previous editions held on the ICTP Campus primarily gathered school educators/teachers.

Press conference with the participation of the ICTP Director and the Mayor of Trieste took place on 26 August. The opening ceremony of the MF was attended by the ICTP Director who gave a short presentation on ICTP's 60<sup>th</sup> year, together with representatives of the FVG and TS municipality (Bandelli).

Special booth for ICTP with promotional material and two treasure hunts organized by PIO: one for children (on science) and one for adults (on ICTP) that helped promote ICTP to a larger audience. Participants were given an ICTP T-shirt.
